

OUTSIDE THE BOX

BEAUTY LIES WITHIN. A valuable life lesson to pass on to the next generation, right? Not to designer Simon Orrell. His jewellery box (£870) may well be equipped to house a handful of diamonds and pearls in its spacious interior, but when the exterior is this gorgeous, who cares about the carats inside?

Heavily inspired by the opulent furnishings and veneers of the Art Deco era, Orrell has crafted his box from a jigsaw of pen-shell pieces, framed by bone stringing, giving it a tortoiseshell appearance and smooth, marble-like texture. For security, a nickel-plated lock guards the contents, though it might be worth investing in a safe to protect the box itself - not at all extravagant, given that future offspring would almost certainly rather inherit this objet d'art than any nugget of wisdom.
