Founders of Mustard Vintage Gemma & Simon Jones talk us through their next project

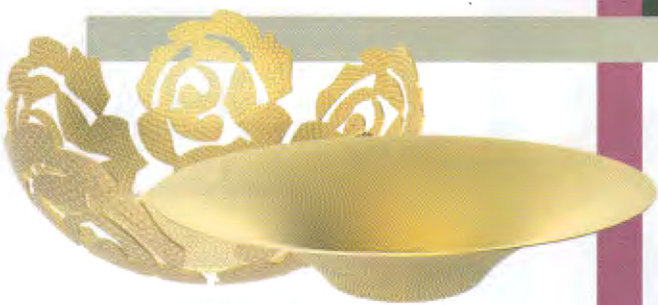
